Authority:

Whereas the board is empowered by Article VII of the Bylaws of the community, Section 1, Powers: The Board of Directors shall have the power to a.) Adopt and publish rules and regulations which shall be binding on each Owner pertaining to the development of the properties...and the Architectural Review Committee is empowered by Article IV of the Declaration of the community, Section 9, Fences and Walls: ...the Architectural Review Committee may designate one or more fence designs as the "standard designs" and may require that all fences conform to these standards;

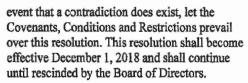
Scope:

Whereas all Lots within the Association should be subject to this rule;

Specifications:

Whereas the standard designs for fencing shall include four (4) to six (6) foot board-on-board wood, vinyl, picket, or aluminum fencing; all aspects of fencing including the design, type, height, and color shall be subject the approval of the Architectural Review Committee.

This resolution shall in no way contradict or replace any provision within the community's Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions. In the event that a contradiction does exist, let the Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions prevail
